The Lowell Police Department currently has sector Captains or their designee attend all neighborhood meetings. Information related to all neighborhood concerns are addressed at these meetings including any potential level 3 sex offender. Additionally, the Lowell Police Department hands out fliers in neighborhoods when a new offender moves in. The Lowell Police Department has a detective assigned to this task full time and constantly monitors any issues related to sex offenders. The Sector Captains can provide information regarding the on-line sex offender registry and how to navigate the site.
