SUBJECT: 4/25/17 Mayor Kennedy – Request City Manager have review possible installation of a sidewalk on Stedman Street in the vicinity of 22 Olde Canal Drive

Currently, there are no sidewalk on either side of Stedman Street. To address this request, we recommend that a sidewalk be installed on the eastern side of the street. There will need to be several crosswalks installed across Stedman Street to provide access to properties on the western side of the street.

Stedman Street is approximately 2,600' long. Our estimate to install brand new concrete sidewalks (and associated crosswalks), with granite curbing, for this long a distance will cost between \$350,000 and \$400,000.

Additional costs would be incurred for drainage improvements which would also need to be made in order to capture the stormwater along the new curbing.
