Pursuant to Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts, concerning Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations", temporary traffic regulations are hereby implemented for a period of sixty (60) days.

The City of Lowell desires to make temporary rules regulating traffic under actual conditions for a period of sixty (60) days; and

Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts", Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations" authorizes the City Council to make such temporary rules for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days;

BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the City Council of the City of Lowell as follows:

Effective immediately for a period of sixty (60) days thereafter, the following temporary traffic regulations shall be implemented:

§266-55

Parking for handicapped persons; elderly drop-off zones – C is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Moody Street (482)	Southwest	Beginning at a point 179 feet northwest from the westerly curblineline of Aiken Street

and running northwest along Moody Street for 20 feet.

Read Street (33)

East

Beginning at a point 20 feet south from the southerly curblineline of Third Street and running south along Read Street for 20 feet.
