My name is Kim, I live @ 219 Jackson St... for 8 yrs. The homeless, Thugs and drug addicts continue to hang out in front of building which is public land. They use the grass as an ashtray, desecrate the benches, sleep on benches, leave clothing in big garbage bags in the area. WE don't care that a homeless shelter is near them - these punks DISRUPT the area. The police do a decent job, I see them on road bikes, segways and cars all the time. I have called the police about 30-40x in the last 8 yrs as my neighbors, I have almost been assaulted 4x in the area.
