ORDER

Pursuant to Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts, concerning Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations", temporary traffic regulations are hereby implemented for a period up to sixty (60) days.

The City of Lowell desires to make temporary rules regulating traffic under actual conditions for a period of sixty (60) days; and

Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts", Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations" authorizes the City Council to make such temporary rules for a period up to sixty (60) days;

BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the City Council of the City of Lowell as follows:

Effective immediately for a period of up to sixty (60) days, the following temporary traffic regulations shall be implemented:

§266-21

Traffic control signal legend – D(2) - is hereby amended by adding the following:

Dutton Street and Market Street

Against northbound traffic on Dutton Street, no right turn on red onto Market Street

Against southbound traffic on Dutton Street, no right turn on red onto Market Street

Against eastbound traffic on Market Street, no right turn on red onto Dutton Street

Against westbound traffic on Market Street, no right turn on red onto Dutton Street

Central Street and Merrimack Street

Against eastbound traffic on Merrimack Street, no right turn on red onto Central Street

§266-51

Fifteen minute parking area – A - is hereby amended by adding the following:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Broadway	South	Beginning at a point 20 feet westerly from the westerly curbline of Cork Street running west for 20 feet

§266-55

Parking for handicapped persons; elderly drop-off zones – C is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

Name of Street	Side	Location
North Street (22)	North	Beginning at a point 362 feet southwest of the westerly curbline of Lawrence Street running southwesterly a distance of 20 feet along North Street.

SUBJECT: PROPOSED 60 DAY TRIAL TRAFFIC ORDERS

DATE: February 12, 2019

Attached is the 60-day trial traffic order for this week as follows:

- No Right Turn on Red – downtown intersections to increase pedestrian safety – all corners of Dutton and Market Street intersection; and Merrimack Street to Central Street.
- No Right Turn on Red – Bridge Street to Merrimack Street and Merrimack Street to Bridge Street, the ordinance exists but signs are missing, need to install signs per Transportation Engineer recommendation.
- Handicapped parking spot – North Street, per resident request.
- 15 minute parking – Broadway per business request.
