RE: *Update of LPS Technology Plan*

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Lowell Public School's (LPS) Long Range Technology Plan for 2015 through 2018 needs to be reviewed and updated for the next three years. The original Long Range Technology Plan was created with the support of the Center for Educational Learning and Technology (Celtcorp). The plan addressed the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education's (DESE) technology benchmarks and demonstrates LPS's level of alignment to the DESE Technology Plan benchmarks. The LPS Technology Department actively focused on the items identified in this plan.

The LPS Technology Department is seeking assistance during the 2019-2020 school year to develop a timeline and plan to assess the progress made towards the completion of the 2015-2018 plan and the development a new Long Range Technology Plan for 2019 through 2022.

LPS as in previous years, would propose working with CELT, now Integrity/CELT, to support the development, implementation, and assessment of a comprehensive technology blueprint that meets the needs of the District, maximizing its effectiveness.
