Please see the attached correspondence marked Exhibit A from the Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA) in regards to the Lowell High School project approval on April 10, 2019.

In addition, as a part of the MSBA’s Accelerated Repair Program applications that were submitted this past February 2019, the MSBA conducted six (6) site visits on Wednesday, April 24, 2019 for the purpose of touring the buildings and learning about the major issues in each building. During the visits, MSBA staff were apprised of past mitigation efforts/repairs as well as programmatic challenges the building issues have created in each of the schools. There were certain restrictions with the eight (8) application submissions due to the large number of applications that the MSBA received in this round of proposals.
