RE: Motion by C. Cirillo – “Request City Manager re-establish the collection of city officials who meet with neighborhood groups to tour neighborhoods to identify areas that need restoration in order to revive the integrity and vitality of the area.”

The Council has asked for an update regarding the reintroduction of the Neighborhood Impact Team walks. These enforcement walks typically include representatives from the Lowell Police Department, Lowell Fire Department, and Development Services, and occasionally include DPW. Attached is a proposed schedule of walks for the Spring of 2019.

Schedule (all walks to be 9am – 1pm):

May 18 – Centralville – Bridge St. Area

June 1 – Back Central

June 15 – Acre – Fletcher St and Broadway

June 29 – Highlands – Cupples Sq.

Neighborhood groups have been informed of these walks, and more information will be forthcoming about each particular walk as the time for the walk approaches.
