





FEMA FIRM 100 Year Flood Map for the City Of Lowell



The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has recently completed a study which re-examined Middlesex County flood zones and has developed preliminary revised detailed, digital flood hazard maps for the City of Lowell. The proposed new maps -- also known as Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs) -- reflect current flood risks. The reason these maps are produced is to provide home owners, mortgage companies, insurance companies and agents and other interested parties information specific to flood risk in areas adjacent to or impacted by local rivers which are subject to flooding.
