ADDENDUM #1

Pick-up & Disposal of Plant Trash, Catch Basin Cleanings & Sewer & Plant Screenings

The number of this Addendum, Addendum No. 1, must be entered in the space provided on the Bid Form.

CLARIFY:

Question: After review of the bid documents. On page 13. It does not list the required type of containers or quantity of containers. Can you tell me how many containers are needed for catch basin sediment and sewer grit screenings? The existing contract requires one 30 CY. trash container that is stored in the building. The existing sewer grit containers are supplied by LWWU. They are constructed to the influent building at LWWU. Does the LWWU dump the catch basin sediment at the Westford St Landfill? Is the catch basin sediment loaded at the Westford St. Landfill on to dump trailers? Do we have to supply the equipment to load the trailers?

Answer: The grit containers will be supplied by the LRWWU. If for any reason LRWWU is unable to pull the containers out of the Influent Building the contractor will be required to pull out the container from the building and replace it with a supplied empty container. This could take place at any time 24 hours a day 7 days a week. The contract requires a 30 CY trash container supplied by the contractor.

The Catch Basin Sediment is currently dumped at the Westford St Landfill. After the material dries it is loaded into dump trailers at the Landfill. The City will supply the equipment to load the trailers. If for any reason the Catch Basin Sediment can no longer be stockpiled at the landfill it will need to be placed in containers at the treatment facility. The Contractor is responsible for supplying and emptying these containers.
