**SPECIFICATIONS FOR  
PICK-UP AND DISPOSAL OF  
PLANT TRASH, CATCH BASIN DEBRIS, SEWAGE AND PLANT SCREENINGS  
FOR THE LOWELL REGIONAL WASTEWATER UTILITY**

**SCOPE OF WORK:**

The City of Lowell is seeking a **three (3) year contract, from July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2018**, for a qualified waste hauler to haul and dispose of plant screenings, plant trash and catch basin screenings.

**GENERAL:**

**I. DESCRIPTION OF WORK**

- A. Under this contract, the successful Bidder (Contractor) is responsible for all disposal and transport of the plant screenings, plant trash and catch basin debris generated by the Lowell Regional Wastewater Utility (LRWWU) from the following sites:
  - a. Duck Island Treatment Facility - Located at 451 First Street Boulevard (Route 110), Lowell, Massachusetts, 01850.
  - b. City of Lowell Westford Street Landfill - Located at 1236 Westford Street, Lowell, MA, 01851.
- B. The total disposal tonnage is estimated to be 2000 tons per year.
- C. The Contractor shall be responsible for furnishing all necessary waste containers. Total bid cost per ton for pick-up and disposal shall include the cost of providing Contractor owned containers to the sites.

**II. COORDINATION AND EXECUTION**

- A. The Contractor shall furnish sufficient equipment to transport and remove the plant screenings, plant trash and catch basin debris generated by LRWWU to an authorized offsite location for disposal. The Contractor will be the transporter of this material and will be required to remove debris on a timely basis 7 days a week.
- B. The contractor is responsible for checking the containers daily and insuring there will always be empty containers available for both grit/screenings and catch basin debris. The

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number of pick-ups will vary from week to week.

- C. The Contractor will be solely responsible for all testing required for the removal, transport, processing of the waste.
- D. The Contractor shall, as condition of award and continuously throughout the Contract duration, maintain compliance with all laws and regulations applicable to the hauling and disposal of the waste.
