

Scope of Services

Oliveria Park Basketball Court Project

85 Newhall Street

Site #5

No work can occur without prior approval from the Superintendent of Parks and Open Spaces

- Clean total surface with compressed air
- Remove all sod/weeds and debris from the general area
- Saw cut and remove broken asphalt debris from edge of court
- Supply and install 3' of new hot asphalt to these areas
- Jackhammer and remove two (2) existing basketball standards with footings and dispose of all concrete and related equipment
- Install two new basketball standards with 5 – 9/16" gooseneck pole and 6' – 0" overhang
- Backboard shall be 42" x 72" rectangular steel with double rim goal. New footings will be 36" wide x 60" deep poured in place concrete
- City of Lowell to provide basketball hoops
- Rout and fill approximately 300LF of cracks with liquid hot rubber and apply 24" Petro Tact membrane over cracks prior to paving
- Shim all low spots on existing pavement surfaces, including the paved arch walkway, with hot asphalt to eliminate any bird baths
- Pave entire surface of court and arch walkway with 2" of hot 3/8 asphalt mix
- Total area to receive two (2) coats of acrylic resurfacer (court area and walkway)
- Court surface shall receive three (3) coats of dark green plexi pave material. Arch way path and surrounding areas outside of court shall receive US Open blue plexi pave material (manufactured by California Product Corp. or equal).
- Texture coat to contain the proper amount of sand to provide a tough wearing base.
- Top coat to contain the proper amount of pigment to provide a long lasting and attractive surface
- Supply/install one set of white textured basketball court lines
- Loam and seed all disturbed areas as needed
- Davis/Bacon regulations apply
- Federal/State wage rates – certified payrolls
- General contractor must be a current member of the American Sports Builders Association
- Site visits by appointment only
