

## City of Lowell Immigration Assistance Commission Overview

The Immigration Assistance Commission advises the City Manager on issues pertaining to the well-being of Lowell's diverse immigrant and refugee population. The amendments to Section 9-25 are intended to clarify that 9 Members are appointed by the City Manager. If the Manager is automatically a member he is appointing nine people other than himself. The City Manager or designee should be an ex officio member because he does not appoint himself. He designates an alternate if he so desires. In total there will be 13 members: 9 appointed by the City Manager and the City Manager himself; the Mayor or designee; a City Councilor or designee and a School Committee member or designee. City Council Confirmation is required. New Code Article VIII S 9-25, 26, 27 Adopted 3/23/2010.

Commission meetings are held ad-hoc, as deemed necessary by the Commission Chairperson.
