To help you address this top priority issue, the City of Lowell Health Department and the Upper Merrimack Valley Medical Reserve Corps are purchasing supplies in bulk and assembling **72-Hour Emergency Kits**. Come assemble *your* kit with previously purchased supplies, to ensure that your family is better prepared. Take advantage of discounted pricing obtained through bulk purchasing, and avoid the hassle of running around to gather needed supplies. One-stop shopping! Your \$50 pre-payment will cover a backpack, emergency disaster guide, crank flashlight and radio, tarp, tent, and various first aid and emergency supplies.

After assembling your kit, you're invited to stay and learn about the local unit of the national Medical Reserve Corps program. (The information session is free and open to anyone who'd like to stop by at 7 p.m. to learn about the MRC.)
