SUBJECT: **MOTION OF 3/10/09 BY COUNCILOR BRODERICK
"REQUEST THE CITY MANAGER HAVE NATIONAL GRID
PLACE A STREET LIGHT IN THE VICINITY OF 112
LAURIAR STREET".**

I have been in contact with Police Superintendent Ken Lavallee regarding the above mentioned motion request. He has informed me that Sergeant Michael Kilmartin went to the 112 Laurier Street and noted that there is an old, low quality streetlight at the utility pole in front of 108 Laurier Street, which is next door to 112 Laurier Street. Also, Sergeant Kilmartin noticed that 112 Laurier Street is embedded in a wooded area, and dark despite being next door to the home with the streetlight. Finally 112 Laurier Street has its own utility pole out front but does not have a streetlight on it.

Sergeant Kilmartin believes that upgrading the existing streetlight at # 108 Laurier Street to a more modern, brighter lamp could possibly improve the conditions in front of 112 Laurier Street.

I will forward this request to National Grid.
