As for Gorham Street #619, this handicap sign was previously voted by City Council on January 13, 2009 as part of the quarterly traffic ordinance and was installed shortly after the approved vote. Upon inspection, the handicap sign for Gorham Street #619 is still in place as of May 5, 2009.
