MEETING

**Park Avenue East**

The proposal of Park Avenue East becoming one way was brought up by the neighbors in the vicinity and communicated to the Engineering Department. The proposed traffic change would carry traffic from the Pyne School driveway (also known as Francis McGee Way) to Knapp Avenue. There is apparent concern by a local Funeral Director that this may impact their operations and ability to manage funeral processions in this area. The Transportation Engineer is still in the process of making contact with the local Funeral Director to discuss this change. Therefore, I recommend it be further delayed until those discussions are complete.

After further consideration, we recommend that this proposal be withdrawn.
