ORDINANCE

An Ordinance Amending the "Code of Ordinances for the City of Lowell, Massachusetts", (the "Code") With Respect to Chapter 266 Entitled, "Vehicles and Traffic".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOWELL, as follows:

"The Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts" hereinafter called the "Code", adopted by the City Council on December 23, 2008, as amended, is hereby further amended with respect to Chapter 266, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", as follows:

§266-1 **Definitions** – is hereby amended as follows: Loading Zone by deleting the words *and transient*. Loading Zones shall now read as follows: An area in the roadway set aside for the accommodation of commercial vehicular traffic.

§266-65 **Loading zones (B) is hereby deleted in its entirety:**
B. The driver of a passenger vehicle may stop temporarily at a place marked as a curb loading zone for the purpose of, and while actually engaged in, loading or unloading passengers when such stopping does not interfere with any motor vehicle used for the transportation of materials which is waiting to enter or about to enter such zone.

§266-65 **Loading zones (B) is hereby amended as follows:**

B. Loading zones shall be in effect Monday through Saturday from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM only.

All provisions of the Code of the City of Lowell, as amended, which are consistent with this Ordinance, shall continue in effect, but all provisions of said Code inconsistent herewith, are repealed.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 43 of Massachusetts General Laws.
