### **PHYSICIAN CONSULTANT**

*Scope of Service: The Physician Consultant shall provide medical consultation, medical support and recommendations on urgent and long-term medical issues, as well as the management of communicable diseases to the City Manager, Board Members, Health Director, Nurse Coordinator, and any other health care providers within the department. The Physician Consultant shall also assist the Board of Health and Health Director in the development of short and long term goals for the Health Department and serve as a liaison with members of the medical community on clinical and public health initiatives. Additional responsibilities may include attendance at City Council, School Department, Massachusetts Department of Public Health, and monthly school nurse meetings. The Physician Consultant shall attend quarterly meetings of the Board of Health and also be a consultant to the City Emergency Management Team. The Physician Consultant may consult on the Ambulance Contract. The Physician Consultant will work with the Health Director and other designated personnel to develop and maintain standing operating procedures and protocols for school nurses. The Physician Consultant must be willing to participate in an emergency dispensing site if deemed necessary by the Health Director and provide prescriptions for medications as defined by exposure. The Physician Consultant must be duly authorized to provide prescriptions and standing orders as required in the School Health Program. Applicants must possess a valid license to practice medicine in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and must be willing to commit an average of ten (10) hours per month, billed at \$100.00 per hour, not to exceed \$14,000 annually. Pediatric, Internal Medicine and/ or Infectious Disease background preferred, MD with MPH desired.
