**MAN WANTED IN VIOLENT ARMED HOME INVASION/SEXUAL ASSAULT
INCIDENT IN MAINE ARRESTED IN LOWELL**

On January 18, 2016 information was received from the Maine Information and Analysis Center through the Maine State Police that a Violent Armed Home Invasion involving a sexual assault had occurred in the town of Lyman, Maine January 15th. Four masked suspects armed with rifles and pistols had entered a residence, assaulting the occupants while stealing property including several firearms. Investigators were able to identify the four suspects and one reportedly had ties to Lowell. On Thursday afternoon, January 21st, members of the Lowell Police Departments Special Investigation Section, Middlesex Sheriff's Office Warrant Apprehension Unit, Massachusetts State Police Violent Fugitive Apprehension Section and United States Marshalls located the suspect at 146 Stevens St. in the Highland's section of the City and took him into custody. **Reynan Mora age 23 of Lowell** was charged with being a **Fugitive from Justice**. At the time of his arrest he was found in possession of electronics that were subsequently identified by Maine State Police as property taken in the home invasion and also a box of 9mm ammunition. Mora was additionally charged with **Unlawful Possession of Ammunition and Receiving Stolen Property over \$250**.

Mora was jailed overnight at the police station and arraigned in Lowell District Court this morning where he was held without bail on the Fugitive from Justice Charge.
