LOWELL POLICE ARREST SUSPECT IN ARMED ROBBERY OF JERRY'S FOOD STORE

On January 6, 2015, detectives received information from several concerned citizens relative to the Armed Robbery of Jerry's Food Store on January 4, 2015. As a result of this vital information being provided to the Lowell Police Department, John Soiles, 30 years of age, was taken into custody without incident at approximately 10:00 P.M. on January 6, 2015. He was charged with Armed Robbery While Masked, and Assault and Battery by Means of a Dangerous Weapon, to wit; Gasoline. He is scheduled for arraignment in Lowell District Court on January 7, 2015, at approximately 10:00 A.M.

The information furnished to the Lowell Police Department was the result of news accounts and video surveillance footage published and aired on January 5, 2015. This information was critical in the timely apprehension of Mr. Soiles.
