**ARRESTS MADE IN HUMAN TRAFFICKING CASE INVOLVING MINOR**

As a result of an investigation into the alleged sexual abuse of a teenager, detectives from the Lowell Police Department's Family Services Bureau today arrested three Lowell men on multiple charges that for one of the suspects includes Human Trafficking. Those arrested are:

**Michael A. Feliz, age 29 of Lowell. Charges: Aggravated Rape and Abuse of a Child under 16 (2 Counts) Human Trafficking.**

**Angel J. Alicea, age 24 of Lowell. Charges: Aggravated Rape and Abuse of a Child under 16 (2Counts), Sexual Conduct for a Fee**

**Michael Alicea, age 18 of Lowell. Charges: Rape and Abuse of a Child under 16, Sexual Conduct for a Fee**

The investigation is ongoing and additional charges and/or arrests are possible. The three suspects will be arraigned in Lowell District Court Wednesday morning. These charges are allegations and the defendants are presumed innocent until proven guilty.
