**REPORT OF ALLEGED SEXUAL ASSAULT DETERMINED TO BE FALSE**

The Lowell Police Department conducted an investigation into the alleged sexual assault of a teenaged victim on Lincoln St. that was reported on Tuesday afternoon November 4<sup>th</sup>. The investigation has determined that the incident as reported by the victim did not occur. The Lowell Police Department considers the alleged sexual assault case closed and we are not looking for any suspects. Residents should no longer be concerned by the possibility of an offender in their neighborhood. A separate inquiry is being conducted into possible charges stemming from this false report.
