MAN CRITICALLY INJURED IN WORKPLACE ACCIDENT

A worker at a glass business on Stedman St. in Lowell was critically injured just before noon today. Emergency responders were dispatched to Ocean Glass for report of an industrial accident. Upon arriving they found a 52 year old male who had suffered a traumatic head injury. Initial information received was that several workers were unloading a flatbed truck delivering large panels of glass. In the process something shifted causing a large, heavy support frame for a glass panel to fall. The worker was alerted to the problem but could not get out of the way in time. He was struck on the head by the frame. EMS workers treated the victim at the scene and had requested a medical helicopter but due to weather conditions, none were flying. Once stabilized the victim was transported by ambulance to Lahey Clinic in Burlington. No other details are available at this time.
