LOWELL POLICE INVESTIGATING FATAL MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT

On February 6, 2015 at approximately 12:25PM, The Lowell Police Department received a report of a pedestrian that was struck by a motor vehicle in the rear of 44 Stedman Street. Upon arrival, officers observed a white male, approximately 45 years of age, pinned between a pick-up truck and tractor trailer unit. Responding officers and EMS Personnel administered first aid and CPR on scene. The victim was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Lowell Police, in conjunction with the Middlesex County District Attorney's Office, Massachusetts State Police, and the Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA) is investigating the matter.

The identity of the victim is being withheld, pending notification of next of kin.
