Dear Chairman Linnehan and Board Members:

I am writing on behalf of the Lowell City Council regarding the matter of Page and Gallagher Fields located at Shedd Park upper. Mayor Samaras, Councilor Cirillo, and Councilor Kennedy made a motion, *requesting the City Manager and the Board of Parks take necessary steps to ensure that the Page Field at Shedd Park remain dedicated to girls softball.* The Council during the Tuesday, April 24, 2018 meeting instructed the City Manager to send correspondence to the Board of Parks expressing the desire of the full Council that no changes be made to the field. The body made it abundantly clear that Page Field remains a field dedicated solely to girls' softball. As I understand, changes to the outfield fence were made in the past, however, representatives of Shedd Park Softball did not believe it necessary to move the fence back to the original position.

Shedd Park Baseball Commissioner member Chris Snow spoke about the need for what is called a 50/70 intermediate field. I will work with the Commissioner of Parks Steve Purtell and city baseball organizations to try and identify potential sites for intermediate fields in various sections of the city.
