BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the City Council of the City of Lowell as follows:

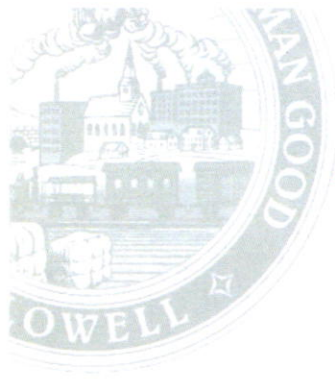
**PARKING FOR HANDICAP PERSONS;  
ELDERLY DROP-OFF ZONES – C.** – is hereby  
amended by **adding** the following:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>
Lewis Street (2)	West	Beginning at a point 60 feet south of the southwesterly curblineline of Market Street running southerly a distance of 20 feet along Lewis Street.

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>
Butterfield Street (56) South		Beginning at a point 172 feet northeast of the northeasterly curblineline of Mt. Vernon Street running northeasterly a distance of 20 feet along Butterfield Street.

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>
Lilley Avenue (44)	North	Beginning at a point 123 feet northeast of the easterly curblineline of Dalton Street running northeasterly a distance of 20 feet along Lilley Street.

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>
Pleasant Street (49)	West	Beginning at a point 1023 feet northwest of the northwesterly curblineline of Sherman Street running northwesterly a distance of 20 feet along Pleasant Street.
