Pursuant to Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts, concerning Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations", temporary traffic regulations are hereby implemented for a period up to sixty (60) days.

The City of Lowell desires to make temporary rules regulating traffic under actual conditions for a period of sixty (60) days; and

Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts", Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations" authorizes the City Council to make such temporary rules for a period up to sixty (60) days;

BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the City Council of the City of Lowell as follows:

Effective immediately for a period of up to sixty (60) days, the following temporary traffic regulations shall be implemented:

**§266-51**

**Fifteen minute parking area – A** - is hereby amended by adding the following:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>
Foster Street	West	Beginning at a point 59 feet north of the northerly curblineline of Middlesex Street and running northerly a distance of 40 feet.

Foster Street                      East                      Beginning at a point 90 feet north of the northerly curblineline of Middlesex Street and running northerly a distance of 65 feet.

**§266-56**

**Parking prohibited on certain streets at all times**  
is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>
Foster Street	West	Beginning at the northerly curblineline of Middlesex Street and running northerly a distance of 59 feet.
Foster Street	East	Beginning at the northerly curblineline of Middlesex Street and running northerly a distance of 90 feet.
Foster Street	East	Beginning at a point 178 feet north of the northerly curblineline of Middlesex Street and running northerly a distance of 60 feet.

SUBJECT: PROPOSED 60 DAY TRIAL TRAFFIC ORDERS

DATE: November 26, 2019

Attached is the 60-day trial traffic order for this week as follows:

- 15-minute spot – Foster Street, per DPW and business request. Currently, parking on the street is unrestricted and vehicles park all day and overnight, making it challenging to plow the street and for vehicles to access the business and the salt/sand pile at DPW. DPW requests that these spots be created so that parking is available for City residents when they arrive to access to the salt/sand pile on the corner of Foster/Middlesex Street. Additionally, the business on the street requests parking for their takeout window.
- Parking Prohibited – Foster Street, per DPW request. DPW requests that parking be prohibited from the corner to the gate access to the salt/sand pile on the corner of Foster/Middlesex Street.
