ORDER

Pursuant to Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts, concerning Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations", temporary traffic regulations are hereby implemented for a period up to sixty (60) days.

The City of Lowell desires to make temporary rules regulating traffic under actual conditions for a period of sixty (60) days; and

Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts", Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations" authorizes the City Council to make such temporary rules for a period up to sixty (60) days;

BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the City Council of the City of Lowell as follows:

Effective immediately for a period of up to sixty (60) days, the following temporary traffic regulations shall be implemented:

§266-56

Parking prohibited on certain streets at all times
is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Jackson Street	North	Beginning at a point 304 feet west of the westerly curbline of Canal Street running west for a distance of 60 feet along Jackson Street.
Middlesex Street	North	Beginning at the westerly curbline of Canal Street and running westerly a distance of 108 feet along Middlesex Street.
Middlesex Street	South	Beginning at a point 82 feet east of the easterly curbline of Thorncliff Avenue and

running easterly a distance of 100 feet along Middlesex Street.

Bus stops designated is hereby amended by **adding** the following:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Middlesex Street	North	Beginning at the westerly curblineline of Canal Street and running westerly a distance of 108 feet along Middlesex Street.

SUBJECT: PROPOSED 60 DAY TRIAL TRAFFIC ORDERS

DATE: July 14, 2020

Attached is the 60-day trial traffic order for this week as follows:

- Parking Prohibited on Certain Streets at All Times – Jackson Street, removal of three (3) on street parking spaces to accommodate the turning radius of the Sheriff’s bus onto the ramp below the Justice Center, per the Transportation Engineer.
- Parking Prohibited on Certain Streets at All Time – Middlesex Street, to add a LRTA bus stop for the Justice Center, per the Transportation Engineer.
- Parking Prohibited on Certain Streets at All Time – Middlesex Street, per motion.
- Bus Stops Designated – Middlesex Street, to accommodate travel to the Justice Center, per the Transportation Engineer.
