**8.7 C. Mercier – Req. City Manager have a coordinated effort among LPD; Tewksbury PD, Massachusetts Environmental Police and the Massachusetts Department of Fish and Game to prevent outsiders from Destroying Neighborhood and Riverbank at End of Burnham Road.**

Below is an update on the general disturbances that are occurring at the end of Burnham Road since the Council Response dated June 23, 2020.

As a result of some council concerns on Burnham Road the Lowell Police Department, Environmental Police, Dracut Police, Tewksbury Police and Methuen Police have conducted dry land and water enforcement. We have found that the beach at the end of Burnham Road is in Tewksbury. The beach is privately owned by a TN Gas Company. The vessels that are coming down river to Lowell are being launched in Methuen for the most part. Lowell Police have been conducting directed patrols on Burnham Road and actively seeking parking and motor vehicle violations in conjunction with our partners. Below is a list of enforcement activities from all combined agencies on July 2<sup>nd</sup> and July 4<sup>th</sup>:

**July 2<sup>nd</sup>**

- 1) 2 summons for attaching tags and or unregistered
- 2) 2 negligent operation of a boat citations
- 3) 3 boating safety tickets
- 4) 7 warnings for various boating safety, or fishing issues
- 5) 2 towed vehicles and or watercraft
- 6) 3 voyages terminated

**July 4<sup>th</sup>**

- 1) 1 warrant arrest (3 warrants)
- 2) 2 citations for unregistered personal watercrafts
- 3) 1 boating safety ticket
- 4) 1 waterski ticket (after hours)
- 5) Assist with follow up with local police department regarding assault at Methuen Boat ramp
- 6) Multiple warnings for boating safety issues
- 7) Several voyages terminated
