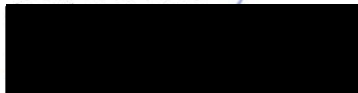
It has been a pleasure being a part of the Election Commission. I am so proud of all we have accomplished in the past few years, and I have no doubt the board will continue these successes in the future.
