The Lowell Senior Center will promote senior participation and facilitate volunteers meetings.

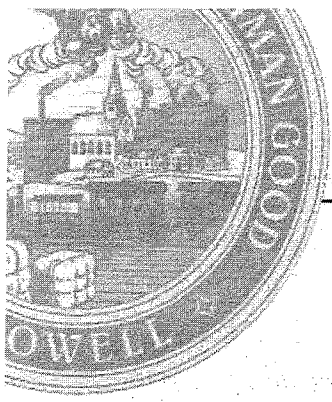
