Re: City Council Motion Response

Councilor Chau - Req. City Mgr. to provide an update regarding Parking Enforcement Procedures on City Streets during Declared Snow Emergencies.

Owners of duplexes or two families are required to provide two off street parking spots per unit for their tenants. The street in question, Florence Street, has multiple duplexes on the street and there is off street parking available, as required, in the driveway. Nothing in the ordinance states that the tenants must utilize the off street parking, it just has to be available to the tenants. If the DPW discovers that cars belonging to the tenants are impeding snow removal, then the LPD would respond by knocking on the doors of the homes or towing the cars.
