Pursuant to Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts, concerning Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations", temporary traffic regulations are hereby implemented for a period up to sixty (60) days.

The City of Lowell desires to make temporary rules regulating traffic under actual conditions for a period of sixty (60) days; and

Chapter 266 of the Code of Ordinances City of Lowell, Massachusetts", Section 266-6 thereof entitled "Temporary Experimental Regulations" authorizes the City Council to make such temporary rules for a period up to sixty (60) days;

BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the City Council of the City of Lowell as follows:

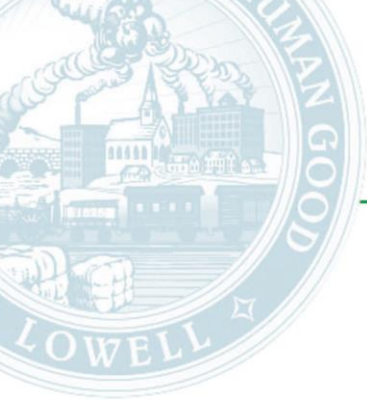

SUBJECT: PROPOSED 60 DAY TRIAL TRAFFIC ORDERS

Attached is the 60-day trial traffic order for this week as follows:

- Parking for handicapped persons – Lawrence Street. Per motion.
- Parking prohibited during certain hours – Broadway. The Merrimack Valley Food Bank delivery trucks have trouble accessing their parking lot when vehicles are parked across Lawrence Street, causing traffic stoppage and delays. A total of three parking spaces will be limited from 8 AM to 3 PM, Monday to Friday. Per business request.
- Two hour parking meter – Hurd Street. Now that the courthouse has moved, these spaces are being made into two hour parking spaces instead of 30 minute parking spaces. Per the Parking Director.
- Two hour parking meter – Williams Street. To amend the current ordinance for Williams Street. The current ordinance reads the parking is on the south side of Williams Street, this changes it to the North Side where the parking spaces are currently located. Per the Parking Director.
