The City was able to obtain this funding through the efforts of our hardworking State Delegation; and

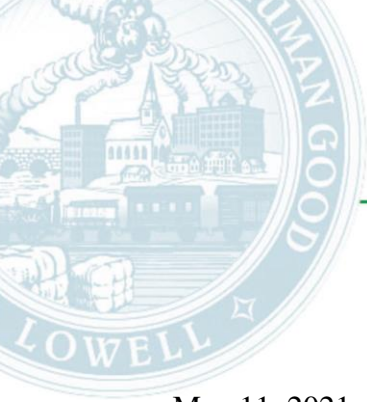
The City of Lowell desires to accept and expend said earmarked funds to be focused on park and playground improvements in the Highlands neighborhood in the City of Lowell.
