### REFERENCE: Approval to Apply/Accept/Expend One Stop for Growth State Grants

Dear Mayor Leahy and Members of the City Council:

The Department of Planning and Development (DPD) is requesting approval to apply for, accept and expend four OneStop For Growth state grants for the total amount of \$9,825,000. The grants, which are due June 4<sup>th</sup>, are as follows:

- 1. Housing Choice Program up to \$250,000 to update the City-wide Master Plan;
- 2. MassWorks Infrastructure Program up to \$2,500,000 to building public infrastructure to support the Acre Crossing redevelopment by Jeanne D'Arc Credit Union;
- 3. MassWorks Infrastructure Program up to \$7,000,000 to construct Phase 2 of the Tanner Street Realignment Project: and
- 4. Community Planning Program up to \$75,000 for a transit-oriented development study around Gallagher multi-modal station.

The proposed infrastructure investments and planning studies will help DPD prioritize planning efforts and enhance City-wide redevelopment opportunities moving forward.
