Re: City Council Motion Response

Councilor Mercier - Req. City Mgr. Provide Installing Special Safety Measures IE, Police Enforcement For Speeding on Aberdeen, Beacon and Christian Streets, As Well As, 6th and 7th Avenues.

The Lowell Police Department (LPD) will be assigning Traffic Enforcement Units to conduct high visibility traffic enforcement on Aberdeen, Beacon and Christian Streets, as well as, 6th and 7th Avenues. Area patrol cars will also be directed to conduct traffic enforcement at these locations as well as directed patrols.

A pole mounted radar speed sign will be installed, one street at a time, on each of the listed streets for two weeks each over the course of the next three to four months.

The Lowell Police Department Traffic Section will monitor and review these measures for effectiveness.
