RE: C. Chau – Request City Manager Investigate Installing A Fence Around the Scullin Park/Morey School Playground Due To Safety Concerns of Parents And Staff

DPW met with the Lowell Public School Facilities Department to review the request to install fencing along the Morey School playground area adjacent to Morey Street and Shaw Street. DPW received a quote in the amount of approximately \$17,000 from the City's current fence contractor, Premier Fence, to install approximately 530 linear feet of 4'high black vinyl coated chain link fence with two gates pedestrian access and another one to provide access for maintenance equipment. DPW is coordinating with DPD to secure Community Development Block Grant (CDGB) funds for to complete this work. The material is currently on back order and work is anticipated to be complete late fall, weather permitting, or early spring 2022.
