This letter has been prepared in accordance with the public notification requirements of the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (MCP) regulations (310 CMP 40.1403(3)(f)) notifying you that a Permanent Solution Statement with No Conditions (PSNC) has been submitted to the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) for the detection of light non-aqueous phase liquid (LNAPL) petroleum in a groundwater monitoring well reported on September 12, 2002, having the RTN 3-0022096. This submittal is available for public review at MassDEP's Northeast Regional Office at 205B Lowell Street in Wilmington, MA 01887 and online via MassDEP's website at www.mass.gov/dep. This release involved the cleanup and off-site disposal of an estimated 500 tons of petroleum-contaminated soils.

Local officials as well as residents of a community in which a release is located may request additional Public Involvement Activities under 310 CMR 40.1403(9). Such requests must be made in writing to the person(s) conducting the response actions and copied concurrently to the MassDEP.
