RE: C. Gitschier – Request City Manager Provide City Council With An Update On The Bulk Item Pick Up Schedule for large items.

Bulk items curbside collection is coordinated directly with Waste Management to schedule curbside pickup by calling 1-800-972-4545. The City's Inspectional Services Division responds to illegally dumped items and issues fines accordingly. To ensure that the Inspectional Service's Division is not fining people for any bulk items scheduled for pick up, the Department of Public Works (DPW) Solid Waste and Recycle office recently began obtaining a weekly list of scheduled bulk pick up items from Waste Management. This list is reviewed weekly by Inspectional Services and checked prior to issuing any fines for illegal dumping. The City started this process starting the week of the January 11th when Waste Management experienced bulk item pick up delays. The weekly bulk pick up list includes the Order (ticket) number, date scheduled, address and item to be picked up. This improved coordination will continue between Waste Management, DPW, and Inspectional Services. Waste Management is currently on schedule with curbside bulk items.
