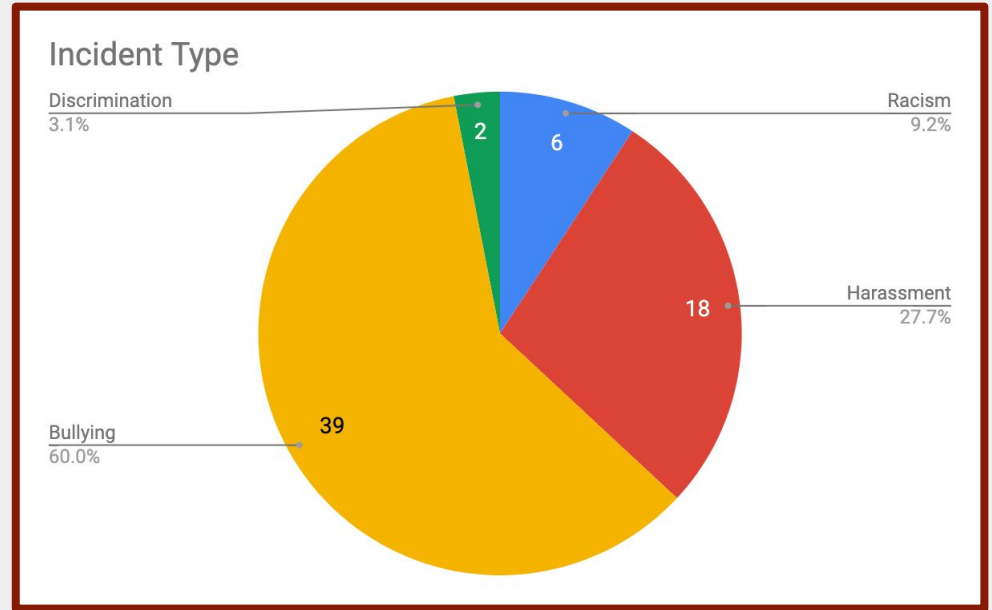


March Report 2022



Total Reported Incidents (March 2022)

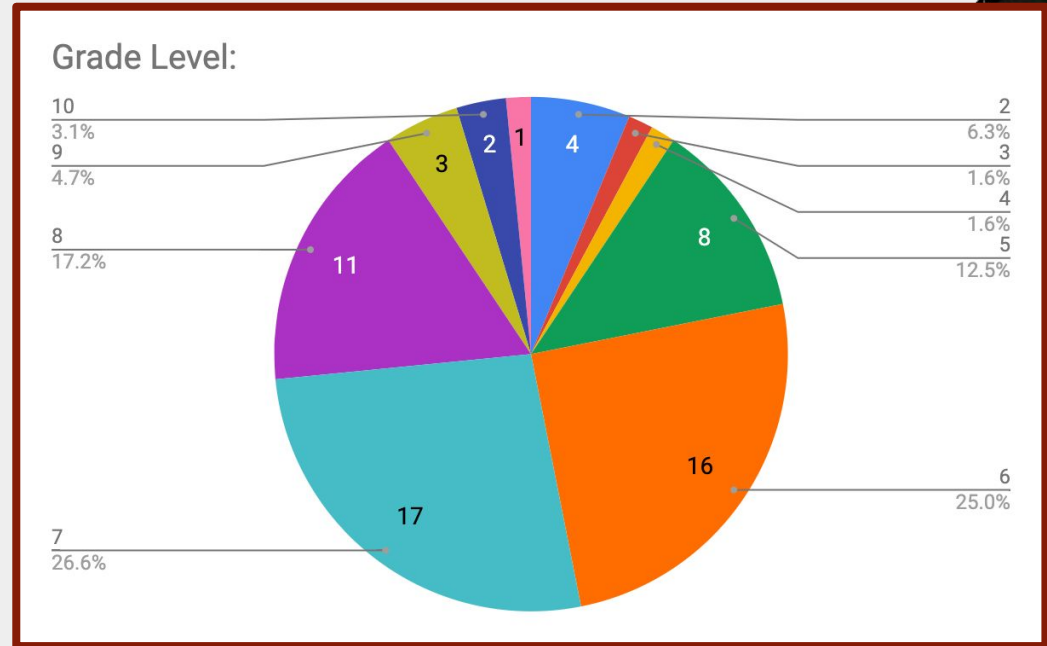
- There were a total of 65 incident reports filed during the month of March, 2022
- 60% of these incidents were reports of bullying
- 9.2% of these incidents were reports of racism





Incidents by Grade Level (March 2022)

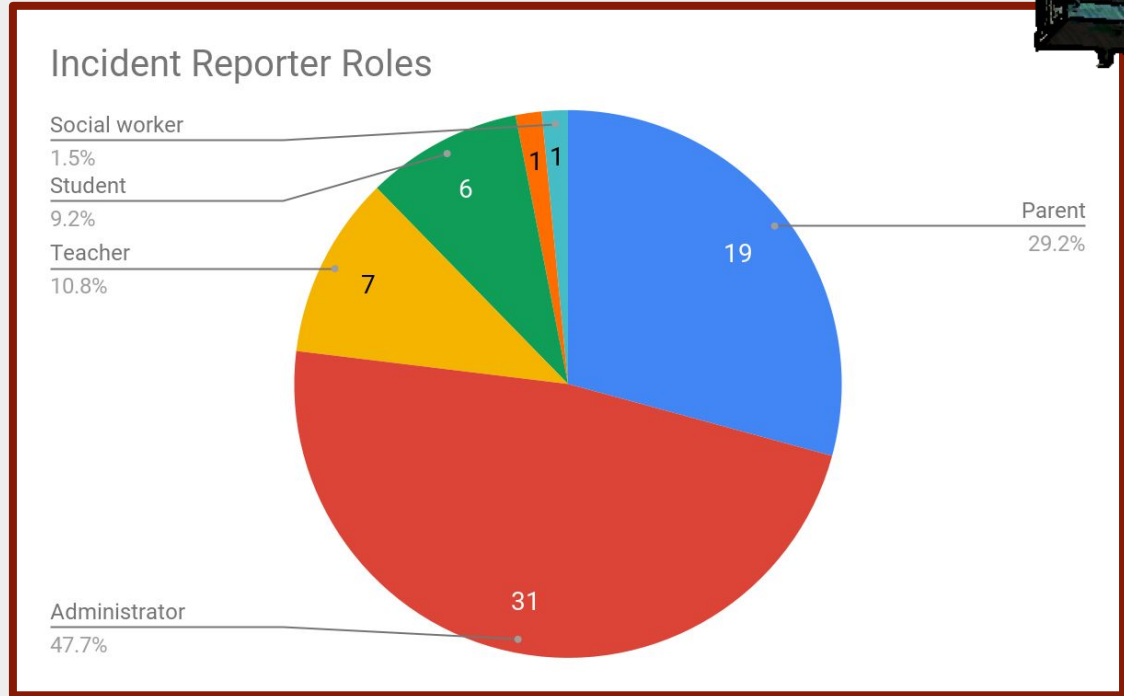
- The majority of these cases (81.3%) were reports involving middle schools, with the greatest number of reported incidents occurring in grade 7



Incident Reporter Roles (March 2022)



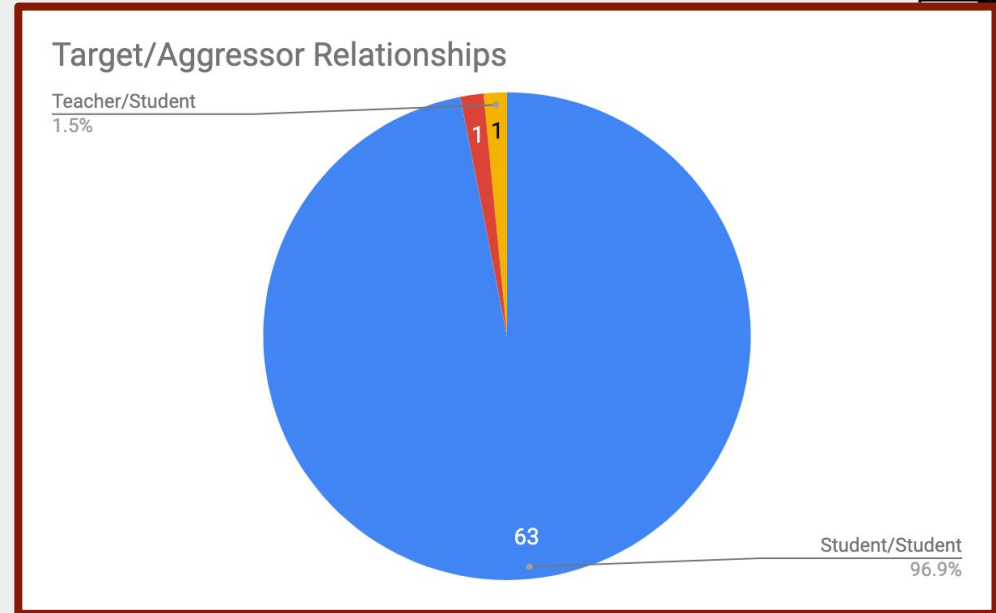
- The majority (47.7%) of incidents were reported by administrators
- The second largest group that reported incidents was parents (29.2%)



Relationships Between Aggressors and Targets (March 2022)



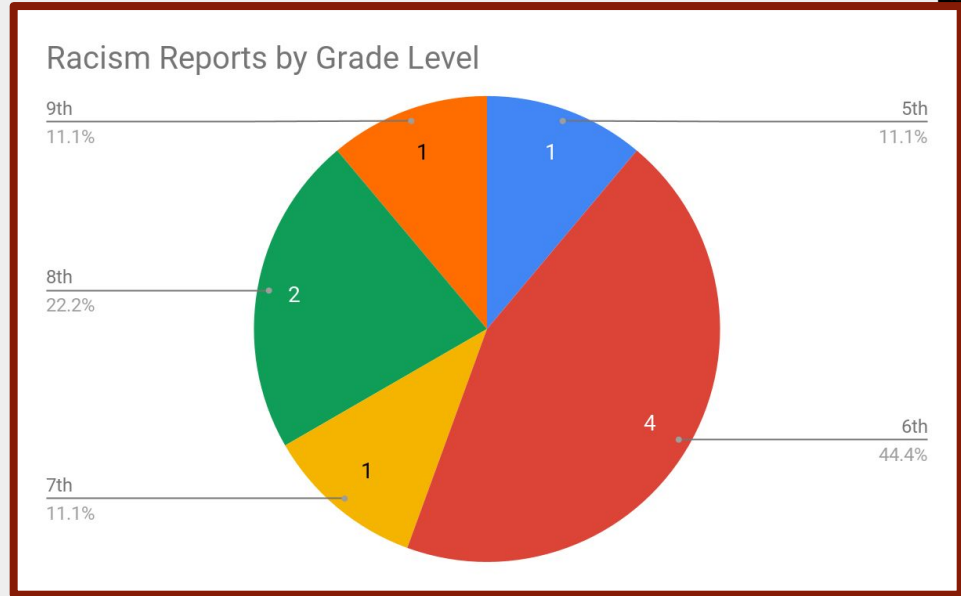
- The majority (96.9%) of reported incidents were between students
- 1 of the reported incidents was student (aggressor) to staff (target)
- 1 of the reported incidents was between staff



Total Reported Incidents of Racism (March 2022)



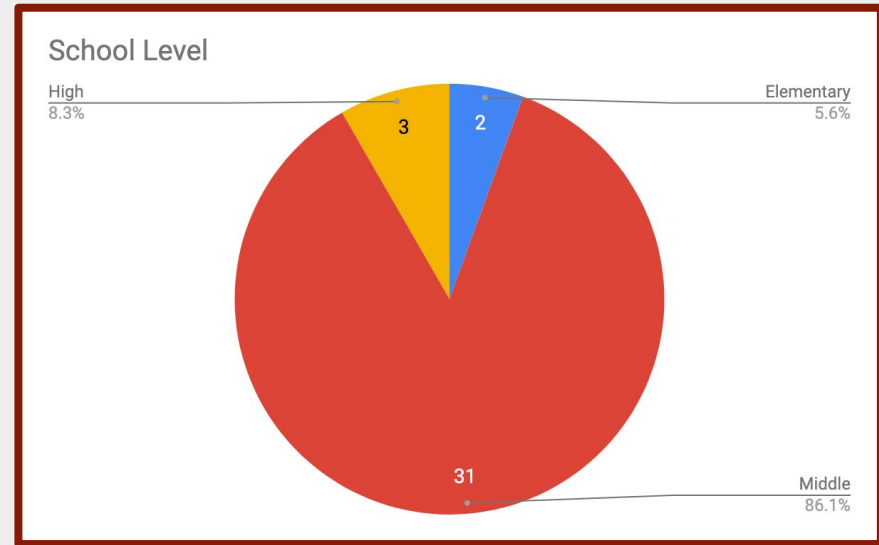
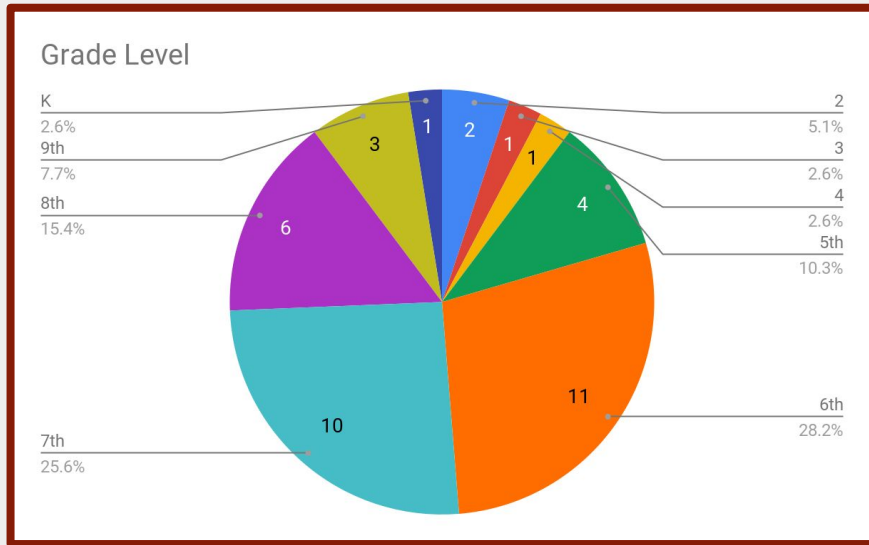
- In addition to the 6 reports of racism by incident type, there were 3 reports of bullying based upon racism, for a total of 9 reports of racism
- The majority of these incidents occurred in middle school
- All reported incidents occurred between students



Total Reported Incidents of Bullying (March 2022)



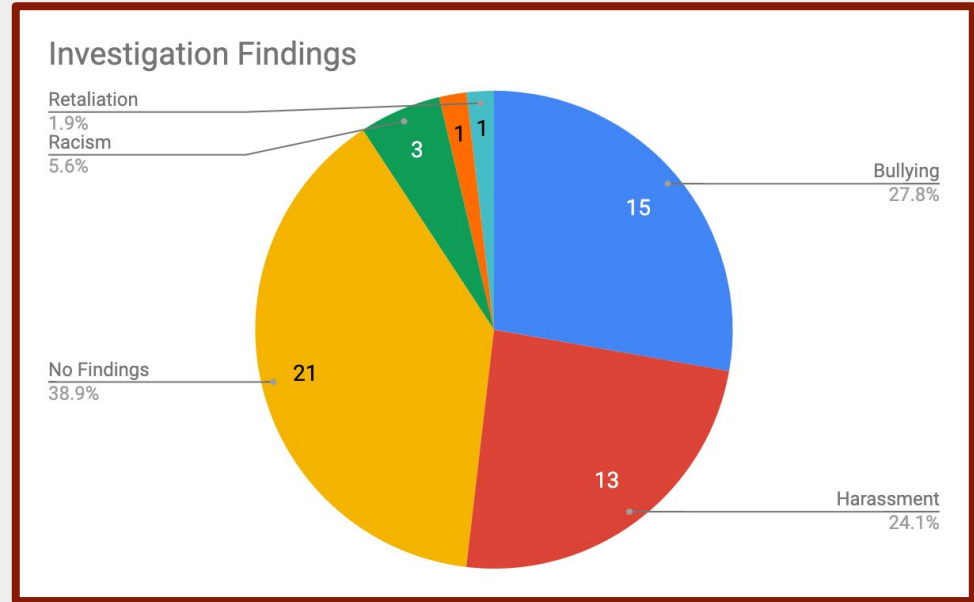
- There were 39 reported incidents of bullying during the month of March, all of which were student to student, with 86.1% occurring at the middle school level



Total Investigated Incidents (March 2022)



- There were a total of 55 completed investigations of the reported bullying, discrimination, harassment, & racism incidents
- 61.1% of investigated incidents of bullying, discrimination, harassment, & racism were substantiated
