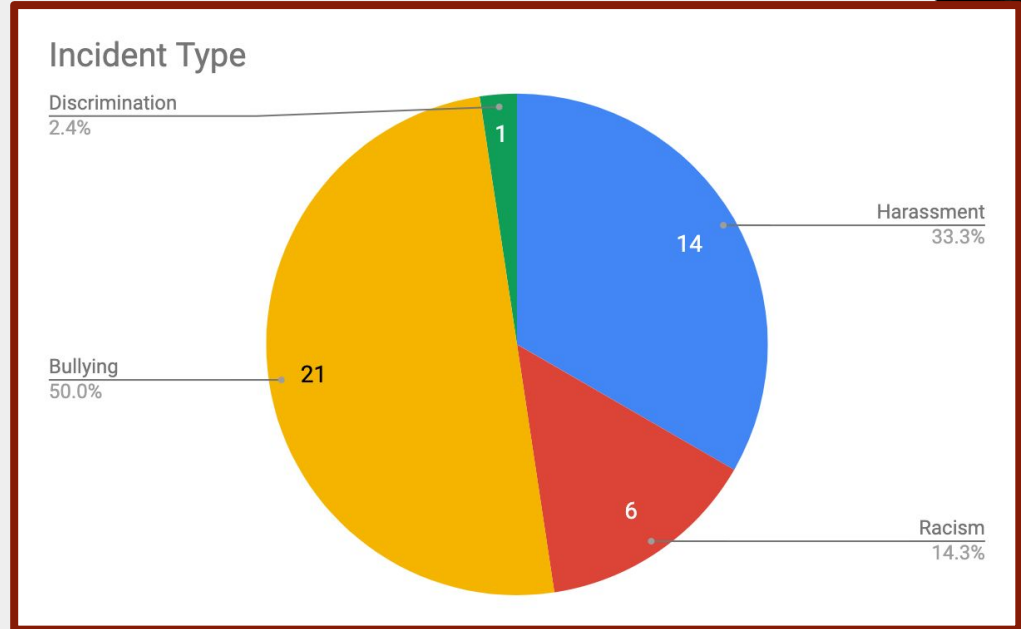


April Report 2022



Total Reported Incidents (April 2022)

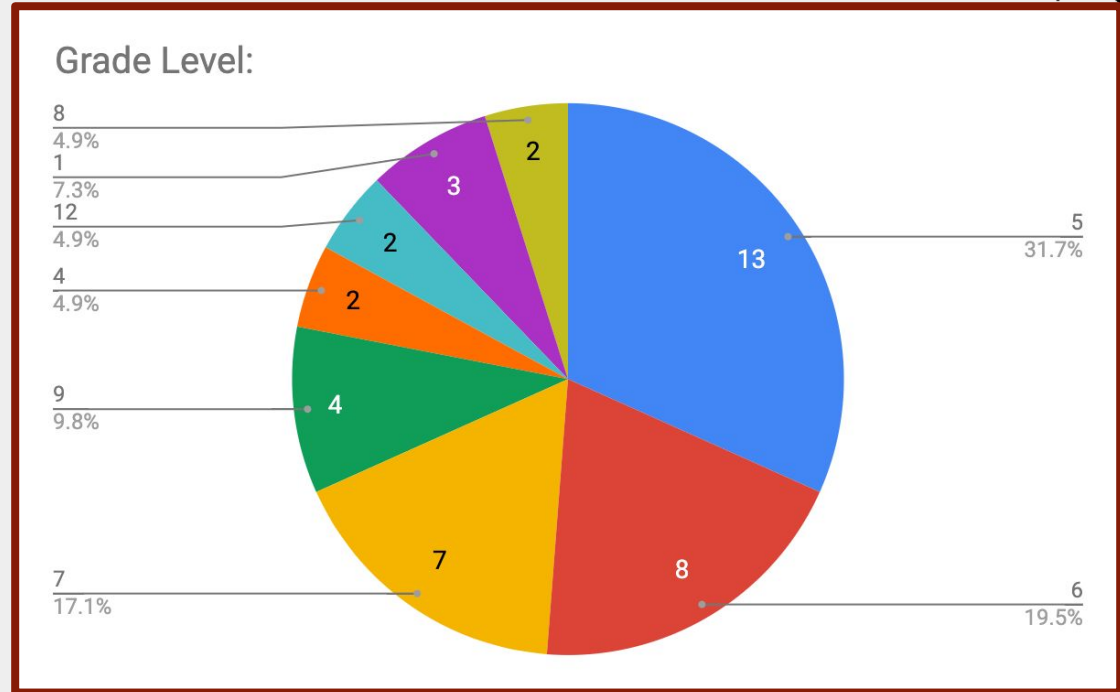
- There were a total of 42 incident reports filed during the month of April, 2022
- 50% of these incidents were reports of bullying
- 14.3% of these incidents were reports of racism





Incidents by Grade Level (April 2022)

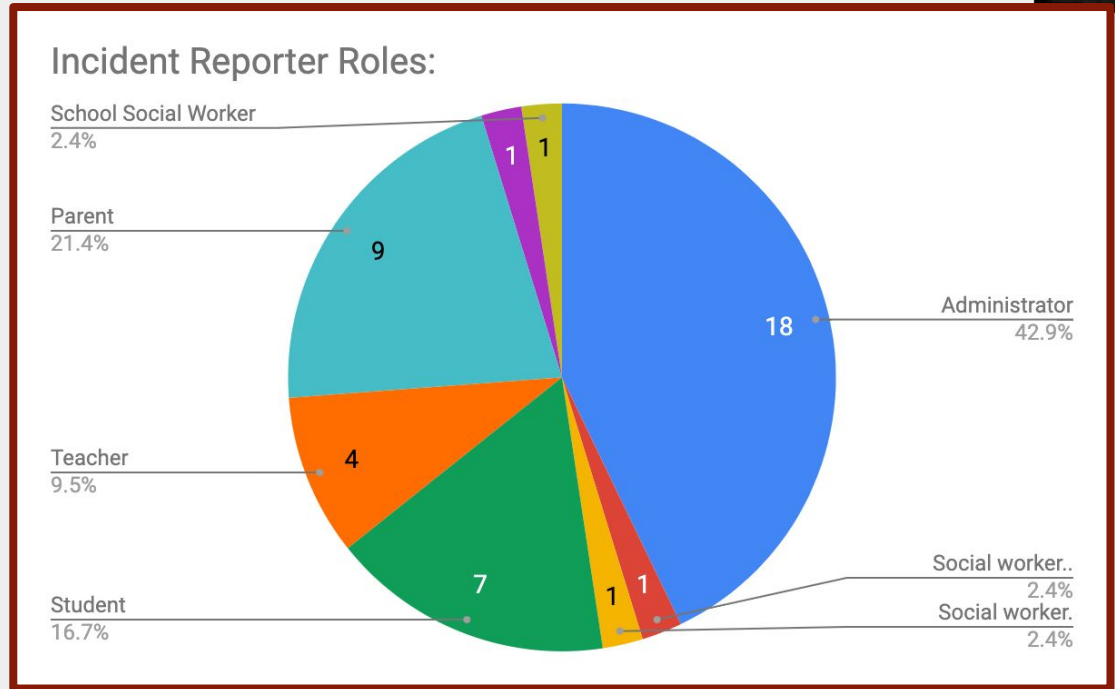
- The majority of these cases (73.2%) were reports involving middle schools, with the greatest number of reported incidents occurring in grade 5





Incident Reporter Roles (April 2022)

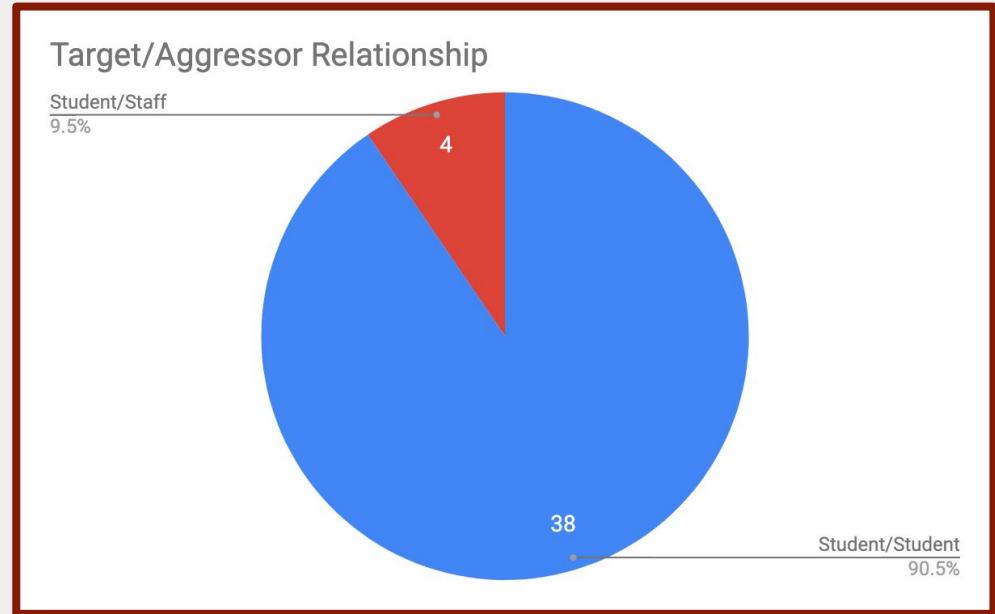
- The majority (42.9%) of incidents were reported by administrators
- The second largest group that reported incidents was parents (21.4%)



Relationships Between Aggressors and Targets (April 2022)



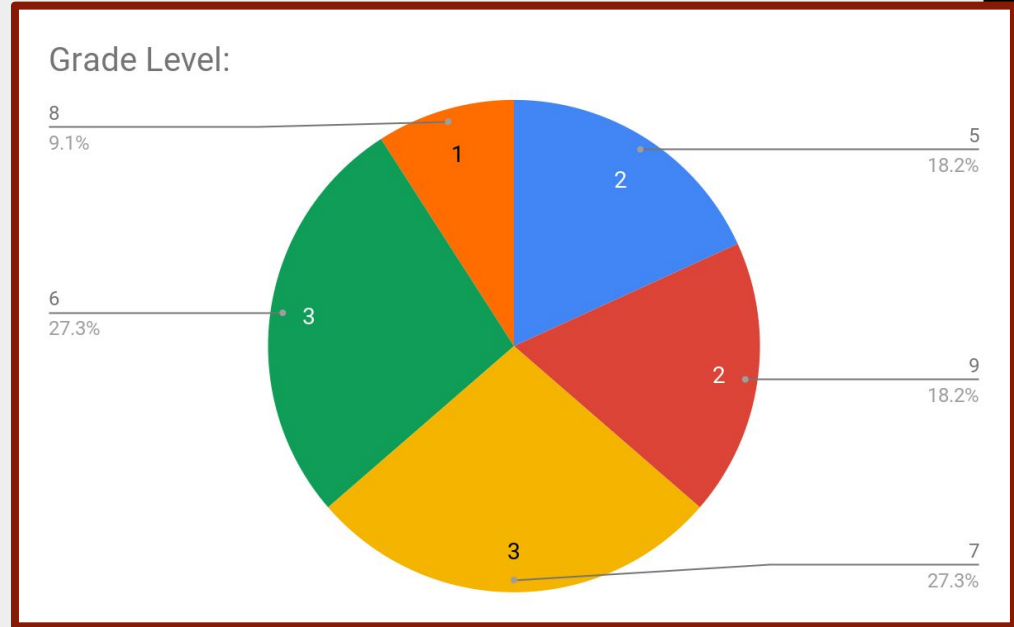
- The majority (90.5%) of reported incidents were between students
- 4 (9.5%) of the reported incidents was staff (aggressor) to student (target)



Total Reported Incidents of Racism (April 2022)



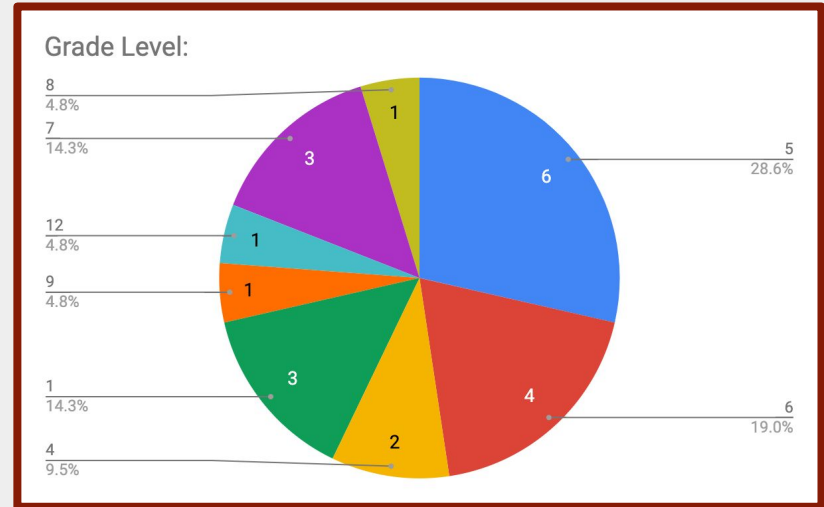
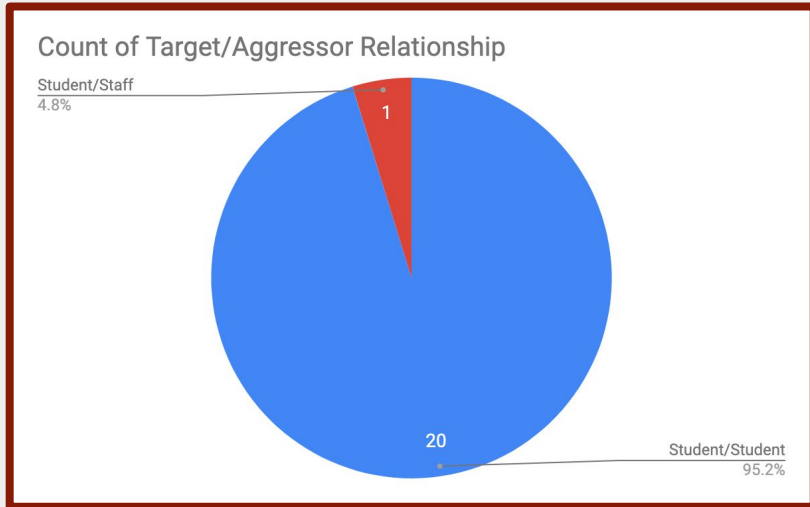
- In addition to the 6 reports of racism by incident type, there were 4 reports of bullying based upon race, and 1 report of harassment based upon race for a total of 11 reports of racism
- The majority (9) of these incidents occurred in middle school
- All reported incidents occurred between students



Total Reported Incidents of Bullying (April 2022)



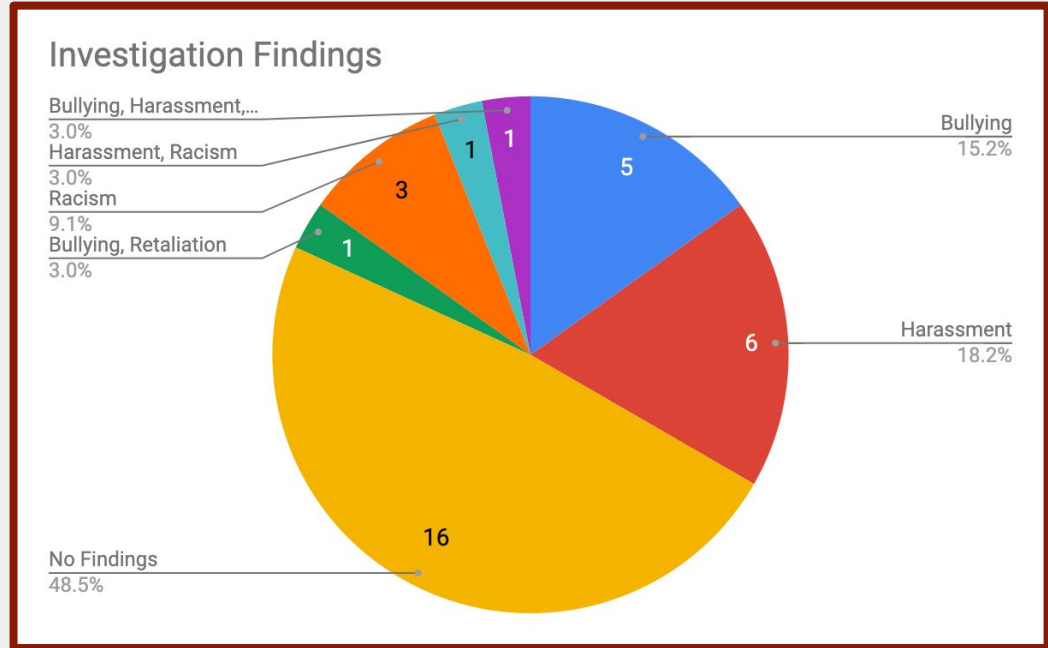
- There were 21 reported incidents of bullying during the month of March, the majority of which (95.2%) were student to student, with 66.7% occurring at the middle school level





Total Investigated Incidents (April 2022)

- There were a total of 35 completed investigations of the reported bullying, discrimination, harassment, & racism incidents
- 51.5% of investigated incidents of bullying, discrimination, harassment, & racism were substantiated
