SUBJECT: MOTION OF 5/17/22 BY COUNCILOR NUON REQUESTING CITY MANAGER HAVE PROPER DEPARTMENT INSTALL A STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF HIGH AND SHERMAN STREETS

City staff conducted a site visit to the above location, as well as reviewed current ordinances and recent crash data to determine if installing a four way stop sign at the intersection of High Street and Sherman Street is appropriate.

Currently, the stop signs are located on Sherman Street. During the site visit, it was observed that vehicles traveling on Sherman Street have some obstructed view of vehicles traveling on High Street. The crash data at this intersection shows that there have been as many as six (6) angle collisions in a 12-month period, collisions that susceptible to correction by a multi-way stop installation. The traffic volumes of these streets, along with the crash data, and the visual obstructions, meet the MUTCD criteria for a four-way stop installation at this intersection.

The stop sign ordinance for Sherman Street at the intersection of High Street will be added to the next 60 Day Trial memo.
