Mayor Chau – Require City Manager have LPD Look Into Cut Through Traffic On Concord Street, From Church Street To Rogers Street, And Explore Possible Use Of Speed Bump.

The Police Department Sign Shop has placed a speed board on Concord Street in order to alert the public of their vehicle speeds in the thickly settled residential neighborhood. The Traffic Division and our STEP Program will begin to conduct speed monitoring and enforcement on Concord Street. Enforcement efforts will focus predominately on morning and afternoon rush hour traffic. We will then be able to better evaluate the matter and discuss our findings with DPD, to see if other speed reduction measures need to be explored.
