Re: City Council Motion Response

Councilor Leahy – Require City Manager Have Proper Department Inspect And Upgrade Crosswalks On Rogers Street In The Vicinity Of Rogers Hall.

Several years ago, the City chose to move the cross walk that was directly in front of Rogers Hall. That cross walk was nearer to the crest of the hill, and the scene of several vehicle pedestrian accidents. This location was also a problem during the afternoon hours with sun glare.

In order create a safer crossing environment, the City moved the cross walk about 20 feet south closer to the intersection of Fort Hill Avenue. The City additionally installed two solar pedestrian crossing signs at this cross walk to improve safety.

The Police Department Sign Shop will be re-painting the existing cross walk. The old cross walk in front of Rogers Hall was left to fade at the time and can still be faintly seen. Christine McCall and DPD will put the old cross walk on their list to have grinded to alleviate any confusion.
