SUBJECT: MOTION RESPONSE: 5/10/22 – Councilor Drinkwater & Robinson – Request City Manager Have Proper Department Look Into Banning Parking on One Side of Street From Area of 37 June Street Down to End of Block

City staff conducted a site visit to the above location, as well as reviewed current ordinances to determine the feasibility of restricting parking on one side of June Street.

During the City Council meeting where this motion was requested, it was noted that there is a large amount of traffic, bus traffic specifically, on June Street. Site visits were conducted at this location during arrival and dismissal hours for the Robinson School and McAuliffe Elementary School. During the site visits, the most amount of traffic was observed to be on the portion of June Street between 13th Street and the driveway for the schools. All bus traffic on June Street was also on this portion.

At the portion of June Street between 13th Street and the driveway for the schools, the width of the roadway is 24 feet. Given the amount of traffic traveling on this portion of June Street, parking on the east side of June Street between 13th Street and the School driveway will be prohibited. This is to avoid the situation of traffic not being able to travel on June Street due to vehicles parking on both sides. The ordinance will be in the next 60-day trial memo.
