SUBJECT: **MOTION RESPONSE #36: 9/13/2022 – Mayor Chau** – Require City Manager Have Proper Department Investigate The Installation Of Pole Mounted Speed Monitors Throughout The City.

The Police Department has purchased three new pole mounted speed monitoring devices. These devices will also record data so that the Police Department and traffic engineer can assess traffic calming and/or speed reduction measures at a particular location. We expect delivery of these three devices within the next four to six weeks.

The City Council, on September 27, 2022, approved the acceptance of a traffic safety grant. Included in this grant is the funding of almost \$10,000.00 in order to purchase two additional devices. The Police Department will then have several units available to move around the city and conduct speed assessments as necessitated by requests from the City Council, neighborhood groups and the traffic engineer.

Residents can also call the traffic bureau and request assistance with speed enforcement and monitoring on a particular street or neighborhood.
