Authorizing the approval and submission of an amendment to the Federal Fiscal Year 2019-2020 City of Lowell Annual Action Plan to provide \$101,654 in unexpended Emergency Solutions Grant-CARES Act (ESG-CV) funds to Eliot Presbyterian Church Day Program.

In May 2019, the City of Lowell submitted a Federal Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

The Federal Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan calls for the anticipated expenditure of \$5,215,382 in funding for the period beginning July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020; and

The Department of Planning and Development seeks to amend its 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan to provide \$101,654 in unexpended ESG-CV funds to Eliot Presbyterian Church Day Program, as more fully described in Exhibit "A".

BE IT VOTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOWELL, as follows:

That the City Council of the City of Lowell hereby authorizes an amendment to the Federal Fiscal Year 2019-2020 City of Lowell Annual Action Plan by providing \$101,654 in unexpended Emergency Solutions Grant-CARES Act (ESG-CV) funds to Eliot Presbyterian Church Day Program, all in accordance with Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.
