Subject: Cultural and Event ARPA Spending Proposal

## Good Morning Councilors,

Here is a breakdown of CASE's recommendations for allocating the \$1.5 million designated in the City's ARPA spending proposal for support for the Arts, Culture and Event Programing. There are eight principal areas:

- City Services for Festivals and events This is a continuation of the program we introduced this year to help festivals return from Covid \$350,000.000
- Public Art Projects This can be a combination of projects directly produced by the City or large public art projects undertaken by outside parties (ArtUp Lowell murals as an example) -\$400,000
- Cultural Organization Grants Direct grants to Cultural organizations. Organizations would have to be either 501(c)3s or have a designated fiscal agent. Organizations would be discouraged from using any ARPA funding for general operating unless they can demonstrate what the plan is for replacing ARPA funding once it sunsets. \$300,000.000.
- Summer Programing Funding for an expansion of CASE produced summer programming -\$50,000.000
- RiverWalk Art Project Matching fund CASE would like to request some funds to do some signage and programming around our RiverWalk sculpture coming this Spring \$10,000.00
- Canalway Cultural District Programming in the cultural district or potentially hiring a part time District Ambassador to promote District activities and business \$50,000
- Cultural Park/Open Air Market This would be a partnership with DPD and help fast track plans they have developed for a potential NEW outdoor Cultural Park \$100,000
- Non-Profit Festivals and Events Direct grants to non-profit festival and event producers.
  Festival producers would need to indicate what their plan is to replace funding once ARPA sunsets. \$200,000
- Reserve Fund \$40,000 contingency fund
