Subject: Motion Response: 2/7/2023 C. Robinson Req the City Manager Provide an update on The Administrations Summer Youth Employment Goals

The City of Lowell is looking to staff summer programs throughout the City in line with previous summer programming. The City Budget would fund approximately 172 summer employees. Shannon grant and School department grants would assist in the hiring of around 59 more employees for a total of 231. These staff would operate programs in the summer parks including but not limited to day programs, free meals programs, pools, swim lessons, tennis lessons, arts and crafts and more.

Staff recruitment began on January 4th with informational emails to 29 community partners about our free lifeguard training program in February. We will be contacting these partners about our April application process as well as additional free lifeguard training opportunities. There will also be a job fair hosted at LHS by the Mass Hire that eh Recreation office is in attendance for. Once applications are received the hiring process begins in mid-April with interviews.
